All life journeys and circumstances are unique, ever-changing, and colored with beautifully different ways of contributing toward our mission of being "Authentic, Compassionate, and Transformative in Our Lives, Our Faith, and in the World."

This guide is offered as a tool to help you discern what "feels generous" within the framework of your own life situation as you consider your financial pledge. Though our financial situations vary widely, we are all connected and therefore this "rainbow of gifts" is reflected in each of us. *Every person and every unique gift are important in building a strong future together.*

RED reflects loving boldly through passion for justice and delight in beauty.

Red contributors come from financially secure households with few debts, which allows them to comfortably enjoy many life amenities such as international travel and leisure activities.

A red pledge may be more than \$10,000 annually.

ORANGE reflects loving boldly in building excitement and sparking transformation.

Orange contributors have abundant financial resources but may also have debts such as college or medical loans to pay down. They are financially comfortable, yet mindful of some potential financial constraints.

An orange pledge may be \$5,000-10,000 annually.

YELLOW reflects loving boldly by lighting the way, and with caution to consider carefully the path ahead. Yellow contributors are living with some financial uncertainty. They may be retired on a fixed income or one that fluctuates from month to month.

A yellow pledge may be \$1,000-\$5,000 annually.

GREEN reflects loving boldly in the joy of tending to new growth and nurturing hope for a better future. Green contributors have limited income and must budget very carefully. Perhaps they are students, have health issues, or other strains on their financial well-being. A green pledge may be \$200 -\$1,000 annually.

BLUE reflects loving boldly in building trust and a solid foundation. Blue contributors have extremely few financial resources. They may rely on subsidized housing or welfare benefits to help meet their most basic needs.

A blue pledge is less than \$200 annually.
